#### **OPEN SHOW RULES**

- 1. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern.
- 2. The Senior Doe and Junior Doe shows are sanctioned separately both days by ADGA.
- 3. The original Registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older. Animals under six months of age may be shown with the original registration certificate or a duplicate application stamped by the ADGA registry office. These certificates must be shown to the show secretary BEFORE THE START OF THE SHOW. No photocopies, telegrams or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
- 4. Animals are to be checked in prior to 8:00 am on Saturday if at all possible.
- 5. The base date for determining the age of the animal is the date that the animal is being shown.
- 6. No dairy goats with horns may be shown.
- 7. The entry fee shall be \$5.00 per animal per class per ring if received by May 24, 2021 (postmarked by May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021). Late entry fee is \$6.00 per animal per class per show. No entries will be processed unless fees are paid, either by PayPal or check. Checks may be postdated May 29, 2021. There will be no refund of entry fees. Substitutions can be made as long as it is prior to start of the show during check in.

- 8. All out of state animals are required by Wisconsin to have an interstate health certificate. All animals must be enrolled in the Scrapie program. Please have your information ready. Goats with a health condition noted by the show committee will be removed from the barns and not shown. If the exhibitor requests a veterinary review, the cost of a veterinary visit will be paid by the exhibitor. ALL goats will be examined before the start of the show. Please check your animals carefully.
- 9. Clipping is optional due to spring weather, but please maintain animal cleanliness for health and sanitation reasons.
- 10. All exhibitors must furnish their own feed and equipment.
- 11. Pen fee is \$6.00 per pen (INCLUDING tack pens!). Exhibitors can show out of trailers but must park to allow traffic around barns.
- 12. \*\* Judging will begin on Saturday at 9:00 AM CDT and Sunday at 8:00 AM \*\*
- 13. Camping is permitted on the fairgrounds, go to; www.elkhorncampgrounds.com or call 262-723-3228
- 14. There will be 2 showmanship classes. They will be shown after the completion of the Sr. Doe shows on Sunday. Milkers used in showmanship may be milked out.
- 15. Please be aware of breed order, <u>animals will stay in their ring area and judges will move</u>. Prompt show order will be maintained and so if you have multiple breeds it is encouraged to have extra handlers to assist and to keep animals ringside.

# ADDITIONAL RULES FOR 2021 ONLY REGARDING COVID-19:

- 1. A mandatory exhibitor's meeting will be held at 8:30 AM on Saturday, May 29<sup>th</sup> at ringside to discuss show ring and ringside COVID protocols and suggested use of social media during the show.
- 2. Masks or gaiters will be required inside the show ring and at the show secretary tables. Masks or gaiters are also required at ringside when social distancing is not possible. Signage designating a "Masks On" zone will be visible. Medical exemptions regarding wearing masks require a signed doctor's note (NOT disclosing any medical condition in accordance with HIPPA Guidelines) and provided to WDGA Board Member Anna Thompson Hajdik.
- 3. Hand sanitizer will be available for use at ringside, inside the show ring, and at other designated spots near the ring. Extra soap will be on hand in the bathrooms. Please wash and sanitize your hands frequently.
- 4. There will be no food stand in operation during the 2021 show. Please bring food and beverages from home.
- 5. The show committee will not be doing any health screenings. However, we ask every person planning on coming to the show (spectator, exhibitor, judge) to ask themselves these two questions the before coming:
  - a. Do you feel sick or do you have any of the following symptoms of COVID-19?
    - Fever of 99.5 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, or feeling feverish
    - New cough
    - Shortness of breath
    - Chills
    - Headache
    - Muscle pain
    - Sore throat
    - Fatigue
    - Congestion
    - Loss of taste or smell
  - **b.** Have you cared for or have you had close contact within the last 14 days with someone who has COVID-19 or who has symptoms of COVID-19? (Close contact means spending a total of 15 minutes or more throughout the course of a day within about 6 feet of anyone who has COVID-19). **If your answer is yes to either of these questions, please stay home.**

LEGAL STATEMENT: These rules may change or be amended as the State of Wisconsin or Walworth County adjusts their recommendations regarding COVID-19 safety guidelines. By entering the WDGA Spring Show, participants acknowledge reading and understanding all of the guidelines and agree to assume any and all risk or injury that may occur to themselves and others they are responsible for such as minor children. The Wisconsin Dairy Goat Association, members and attendees, the Walworth County Fairgrounds and its members and employees are released from all liability, cost and damages which may arise from attending/ participating in this event.

Note: We are not requiring vaccination, as we know not all can be vaccinated, but want to encourage those who are coming to the show to get vaccinated if possible as that does offer the best protection. If not possible and you or a family member have high-risk health issues, seriously consider if attending is in your best health interest and do so at your own risk.

Finally, to encourage mask compliance, the show committee will offer prizes to the most original mask designs in the following categories: 1) Goat-Themed, 2) Most Colorful, 3) Funniest and/or Most Creative. There will also be a youth category.
